The Transition Program's 12th Annual Lock-In will be held from dismissal on Friday, May 3rd, until **11pm that evening**. During this time, students will be "locked-in" the John Humphrey Campus. The cost to participate in this event is \$20.00 (exact cash or check made out to SWCCCASE). Due to a limited amount of space and staff, student participation is capped at 50 students. In order to secure your student a spot at the Lock-In, all permission forms and money must be turned in together, as soon as possible, or at the latest, by **April 30th**.

In addition, because this is an activity held after school hours, someone must be available to pick-up your student at *anytime*; for example, if your student would like to leave, an emergency occurs, or if your student does not follow the rules/expectations of the Lock-In. Upon dismissal that Friday, staff will start the evening with a review of the rules and expectations for the Lock-In.
